Thank you... two of the most powerful words. As the Southwest Pipeline Project (SWPP) continues to progress and nears completion it becomes more evident to me the importance of those two words. The project continues to reach its vision despite whatever challenges encountered as the result of

many. From the daunting task of securing funding, planning and construction to the day-to-day operations, it takes hard work and perseverance to progress and bring a reliable source of quality water to southwest North Dakota. Thank you... to the many individuals who share their time, talent and treasure to reach the ultimate vision of "People and business succeeding with quality water."

At the November Southwest Water Authority (SWA) board of directors meeting, the budgeting process was approved and water rates were set for 2010. Rates are carefully reviewed annually to determine if changes are needed to maintain operations. Due to rising costs, there will be a slight water rate increase for rural and contract water customers. Rates will increase five cents from \$3.12 to \$3.17, per thousand gallons of water for contract customers and five cents, from \$3.65 to \$3.70, per thousand gallons of water for rural water customers. Standard minimum rates remain the same at \$41.10 per month. On behalf of the board of directors and the entire staff at SWA, thank you to our customers. It is with your support that we continue to bring a reliable source of quality water to southwest North Dakota.

SWA is governed by a 14-member board of directors representing the 12 counties and the city of Dickinson in southwest North Dakota. The board meets monthly to discuss the operations, maintenance and progress of the SWPP.

Southwest Water Authority (SWA) offers Automatic Payment Plan. You can have your payment made automatically from your checking or savings account. There is no check to write, no payment to mail, no more late fees, no more forgetting to pay, and Automatic

Payment Plan is FREE! This may also be convenient for people who leave for the winter months.

How Does Automatic Payment Plan Work?

Automatic Payment Plan lets your financial institution do all the work. Each month, the amount due on your SWA bill is automatically deducted from your designated bank account on the 20th of the month. The proof of payment will appear on your monthly bank statement. It will still be important for you to call, e-mail or mail in your meter reading monthly.



Automatic Payment Plan will cost you nothing. In fact, you will save time and money with no check writing expense and no postage costs.

How Do I Sign Up?

Sign up is simple. Complete the Authorization Form below and return it to SWA. Please attach a blank, signed check marked "VOID." This will be used to record the bank information necessary to process the payments.

You can designate a checking or savings account. Make sure the signatures match bank records. If the bank account is in two or more names, all account holders must sign.

How Long Does It Take For Automatic Payment Plan To Go Into Effect?

Automatic Payment Plan will usually take one month to implement. A note indicating this will appear on your water billing statement. Please continue to pay your bill as usual until you see this note.


